New Outdoor Payment Terminal Set to Transform Remote and Unattended Refuelling

The launch of the new Outdoor Payment Terminal (OPT) by TT Fuel does not only herald a massive leap forward in capability for the Adelaide based global technology company, but it is also set to transform the security and efficiency of unattended refuelling sites and become the industry benchmark.

Comprehensive monitoring of wet-stock movements combined with real time monitoring through the fully automated critical event notification service means that any abnormality or risk event can be addressed quickly”.

This is the first major product release to have resulted from an extensive investment in technology development by TT Fuel over the past few years.

The OPT is fully supported by TWeb web-service allowing automated and remotely managed price changes, inventory reconciliation and comprehensive sales reporting.

Most significantly, the TT8800 supports a number of payment options, including debit account cards, Visa cards, MasterCard, AMEX cards and WEX Motorpass as well as private account card networks.
